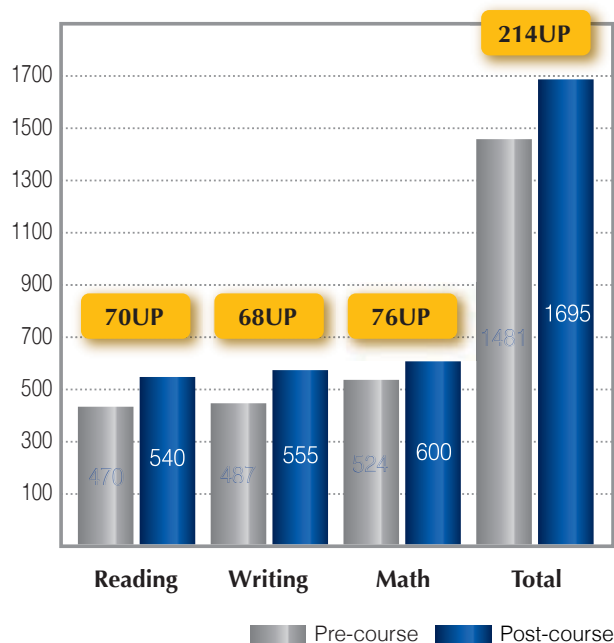

AGOS Japan (formerly The Princeton Review of Japan) has been offering SAT instruction in Tokyo for over 20 years. The ASIJ on-campus SAT Strategy courses will use the same materials as the courses held in our Shibuya offices, but have been shortened to fit into the busy schedules of ASIJ students. Instruction will be done primarily after school in ASIJ classrooms.

During the 32-hour course, you will learn to recognize every question type found on the SAT and learn strategies to attack each of them. You will also be taught study strategies that can be applied during self-study as well as throughout your regular school day.

The classes are fast-paced, but offer plenty of practice and review. Since most lessons will occur at the end of the school day, they are structured so that you will never be overwhelmed by too much new content in any one class.

No matter how close you are to your target SAT scores, you will benefit from focused attention to strategies for this daunting standardized test.



Critical Reading

Reading for the SAT demands the use of analytical skills and inference. A wide vocabulary is also vital to performing well. These lessons will teach not only SAT strategies, but also ways to accelerate vocabulary acquisition and hone critical reading skills in regular school studies.

Writing

The Writing lessons focus on the most commonly tested grammar points on the SAT, how to spot them, and how to eliminate incorrect responses. Attention is also paid to writing a stronger essay. Three essays will be written and graded within the course.

Math

Even excellent math students show score improvement after learning strategies to avoid making simple mistakes and choosing too quickly. While the SAT Math section tests a broad range of knowledge, the questions are consistent in style and a focused approach yields real score benefits.

Diagnostic Level Check and Full Practice Test

The first class meeting will consist of a two-hour diagnostic level check. It will be comprised of a sampling of all the question types found on the full SAT. This will allow you to get a reliable estimate of your own strengths and weaknesses before the class begins. At the conclusion of the course, there will be a full diagnostic practice test. This will be followed by a two-hour review session.

One-day Practice Test and Review

These six-hour sessions include a full practice test, as well as a two-hour post-exam strategy review to help you focus on the areas in which you need the most attention. We offer the one-day events several times each test season, shortly before the actual exam is to be held.

SAT Refresher

The Refresher is a 15-hour course for those who have completed the Strategy course and would like an extensive review of strategies before the next test.

Private Tutoring

One-on-one instruction can be arranged to meet many individual needs, such as a desire to concentrate deeply on one section of the test, or to work at a more customized pace.
